Fire Chief's Report

We ran 9 calls for the month of October. 2 - EMS, ALS, 1 Commercial Fire (tractor trailer), 2 Still Assignments (smoke investigation), 3 Motor Vehicle Collisions, 1 Mutual Aid Extrication provided to Bowie Fire District.

One of the EMS supply cabinets has been assembled and stocked. The other arrived last week and is waiting to be assembled.

The Squad was reorganized so that it is easier to find equipment. The SCBA's, spare SCBA bottles and O2 bottles have been mounted in proper mounting brackets.

Our cardiac monitor and AED's have been returned. There were no issues found with any of the units.

The fire district participated in the Halloween carnival at the school. We handed out bags with fire prevention materials inside. Afterwards, we handed out candy at the station.

The fire district conducted a fire/safety inspection at the San Simon school on October 28th. A follow up meeting was conducted on Friday the 7th with the teachers and superintendent.

The hard drive on the office computer died last Friday. Kevin Wilstead was able to get one of the spare computer towers up and running. He estimates this computer should get us through to the next fiscal year, so we can budget for a new one. However, there is needed information on the hard drive we seriously needed to continue fire district business.

Fire Ant, LLC donated a bunch of wildland equipment to the fire district. I've attached an inventory list. This brings us closer to having the brush truck equipped as mandated by Arizona Forestry Department and the Feds.

My drug box has arrived. The San Simon Fire District is officially an Advanced Life Support agency.

On November 4th, I was requested by HCI's General Manager to respond and assist on a MVC which had 2 fatalities and a Level 1 trauma patient. The wreck was located between Bowie and Wilcox. I ended up riding in the ambulance to Wilcox Hospital, assisting the Paramedic with patient care.

We are still waiting for the loan documents for the tender to arrive.

Sunsites-Pearce fire district has loaned us their hose tester for a couple of weeks.

I cancelled our Southwest Gas account. This will save us around \$25.00 dollars per month.
